## 2020 UCSC Elections – SUA Constitutional Amendment Results

### SUA Constitutional Amendment [undergraduate]

This amendment to the SUA Constitution attempts to balance the lopsided power dynamics within the SUA to allow for an equal balance of power between colleges, student organizations, and at-large students. A dedicated transfer and re-entry student representative is added. Further, refinements are made to the SUA Judicial Council, Officer Recall Procedures, and mechanisms for how conflicts of interest are addressed in the space. Several additional changes are elaborated upon in the Guide document following this statement.

A vote of YES is a vote in favor of adopting this amendment effective immediately. A vote of NO is a vote against the adoption of this amendment.
